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ON-SITE DIGITIZATION POLICY

To accommodate the resource needs of the institution in the application of new technologies for the benefit of education and research purposes in the fields of Architecture and Art History.

To licence the use of photographic images created by HARTILL ART ASSOCIATES for specific on-site/campus ONLY purposes related to the educational/research requirements of Faculty and Students. Copyrights and ownership will thus be protected and others' rights will not be infringed. It is permissible to scan and digitise for on-site/campus use and Distance Learning only, of purchased images for Teaching & Research purposes.

There is a sliding scale of fees applied based upon the images purchased, the resolution level required and the quantity that the Visual Resources Specialist wishes to have scanned and digitised.

Certain images may be unavailable for digitisation where HARTILL ART ASSOCIATES does NOT own the Copyright for such images. It is strongly recommended that you advise us of any planned digitisation procedure involving earlier purchases by the institution in order to avoid legal complications.

This Policy applies to all Education institutions, with or without an appointed Visual Resources Specialist in charge of the Visual Resources Department.

It is important to note that a separate Licence Agreement is available for the placement of images onto the Internet/World Wide Web. Current Commercial usage rates will apply.

An Agreement to cover the scanning and storage of such images, copyright obligations, and limitations on usage of images scanned and digitised, is offered in the Agreement to the department initiating an order for slides from HARTILL ART ASSOCIATES.
